This state-of-the-art wine producing facility is located on a vineyard in southern Oregon. The split-level design utilizes the existing slope of the site with a 12-foot high concrete retaining wall to help facilitate the grape processing and fermentation, utilizing gravity instead on mechanical pumps. The facility is oriented to provide a shaded open-air work area and take advantage of both solar access and natural day-lighting.

The 12,838 sf pre-engineered metal building is clad with American Building's Standing Seam 360 roof system and R-Panel wall system. Roof mounted solar panels add to the sustainability features of this project.
