Alta is one of the first schools in the state to complete a field house for their various athletic teams to utilize year-round. The 20,350 square-foot building features rigid frame and lean-to clear span framing, as well as a partial mezzanine with 30' eave height that in certain locations cantilevers several feet away from the building. This observation room also boasts large windows facing the stadium for guests to watch football and track and field events in inclement weather conditions.

The main portion of the building houses the practice field with a 50-yard by 30-yard artificial turf field with grid lines. A batting cage is suspended from the ceiling that can be raised and lowered as needed and an under-hung protective netting spreads around the perimeter. A large meeting room upstairs and concession stands downstairs, as well as a referee room complete the facility. A 1,546 sf separate garage was included in the project. Additionally, large custom vinyl logo graphics have been installed on the sides of the building.
