Warped Wing Brewery, an established craft brewer, expanded their barrel-aging beer operations with a new multipurpose building consisting of two structures; a larger structure with a peaked roof for barrel aging and distribution operations, and a taproom with a single slope roof that abuts at one peaked end. The taproom structure is offset to corral the Bier Garten on one side and create the hidden back dock area on the opposite side. The two structures join over the bar creating a recessed open ceiling, taller than any other in the taproom. The use of an American Buildings structure allowed clear spans and clear heights for the Warped Wing operations while still enabling designers to create an inviting atmosphere for guests. The truck dock is recessed approximately 40 feet into the building, requiring additional coordination with foundations, slab work and interior and exterior elevations. The facility highlights the barrels in large-lit, glazed openings in the over 4,000 sf conditioned storage area. Kegs are also stored in the facility in the interior 4,000 sf cold box. From the taproom you can view the pilot brewing system including the fermentation tanks and the brew house, built for small batch beer production. Repurposed materials, including a barrel stave wall, pallet wood, barrel hoop lighting, and salvaged steel, bring the space together making the taproom warm, interesting, and inviting. The outdoor Bier Garten features a steel arbor that highlights an outdoor seating area.
