HOW TO TAKE YOUR BUILDING PHOTOS LIKE THE PROS:

- 1. Set your camera to the highest quality setting
- 2. Do not crop, resize, or modify your photos before submitting
- 3. Photograph your building from all angles and sides
- 4. Take close-ups and distance shots, as well as interiors if possible
- 5. Try to time it so the sun is to your back, near dusk or dawn is best

Images such as interior shots, shots from different sides of the building, and photos during the construction progress are appreciated. Professional photos are preferred, but not required.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

Any American building you have completed, that has not been recognized in a previous EID competition, is eligible. Projects must be submitted by October 31, 2023.
