Training Facility/Campus

This state-of-the-art facility serves as the headquarters of the Northwest Line Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee and a training center for aspiring linemen. The project encompasses two custom metal buildings. The main building boasts eave and ridge heights of 32' and 48', respectively, sufficient to house lineman poles in a 14,000 sf indoor training yard.

Amenities include a mezzanine that overlooks the training area, translucent wall panels that convey natural light, classrooms, offices, and storage. An 18,000 sf structure houses a board room, conference and break rooms, offices, a commercial kitchen, and three partitioned classrooms that easily convert into a 5,000 sf multipurpose room. An IMP roof helped the project meet code requirements, while the walls utilized a stylish mix of IMP, CMU, and flat panel siding.
