The job you've done a thousand times is the one to watch.

Familiarity breeds shortcuts. Use these checks to catch complacency before it catches you:



Ask: "If it were my first time doing this task, what would I check?"



Do a real PPE check — not just a glance.



Walk the area fresh. Conditions change even when the job doesn't.



Say the hazard out loud. Naming it breaks autopilot.



Watch for "I've always done it this way" — that's the warning sign.



Rotate routine tasks if possible. Fresh eyes catch what familiar ones miss.
